We tend to think of ourselves as straightforward, easygoing people and that tends to show through in our beers, hence our slogan: Made From Ingredients. We like beers that are drinkable, unique, and disappear from your glass without you realizing it.

We think the science and skill behind brewing is fascinating and could talk shop for hours (hence our name, "Bone Up," which means to learn more about something), but at the end of the day, beer is fun and sometimes, you're allowed to simply enjoy it!





# 2022

2022 was full of the ups and downs, strikes and gutters that you'd expect, but also it (eventually) started to feel like that "return to normal" that we spent the better part of two years yearning for, only once we returned to normal, we learned that this normal still isn't normal, you know?

It was definitely an interesting year - we started out with Covid Winter Part Two and then managed to settle in to something that almost felt normal for the first time in years. It's been a hell of a ride these last six or so years, and we've made a lot of friends with a ton of cool people we wouldn't have otherwise been able to meet, and we can't wait to keep doin' more cool stuff with you and for you!

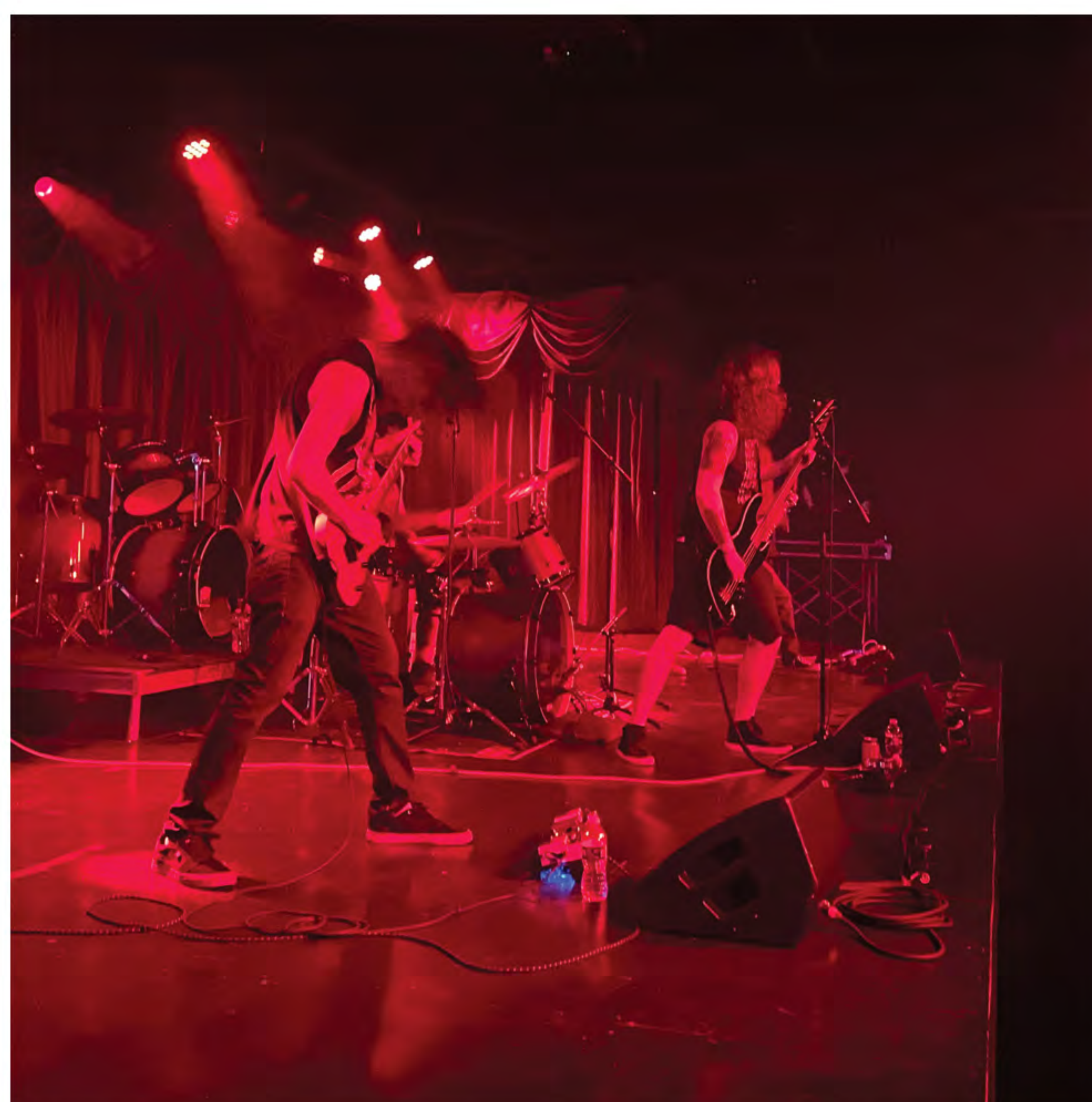
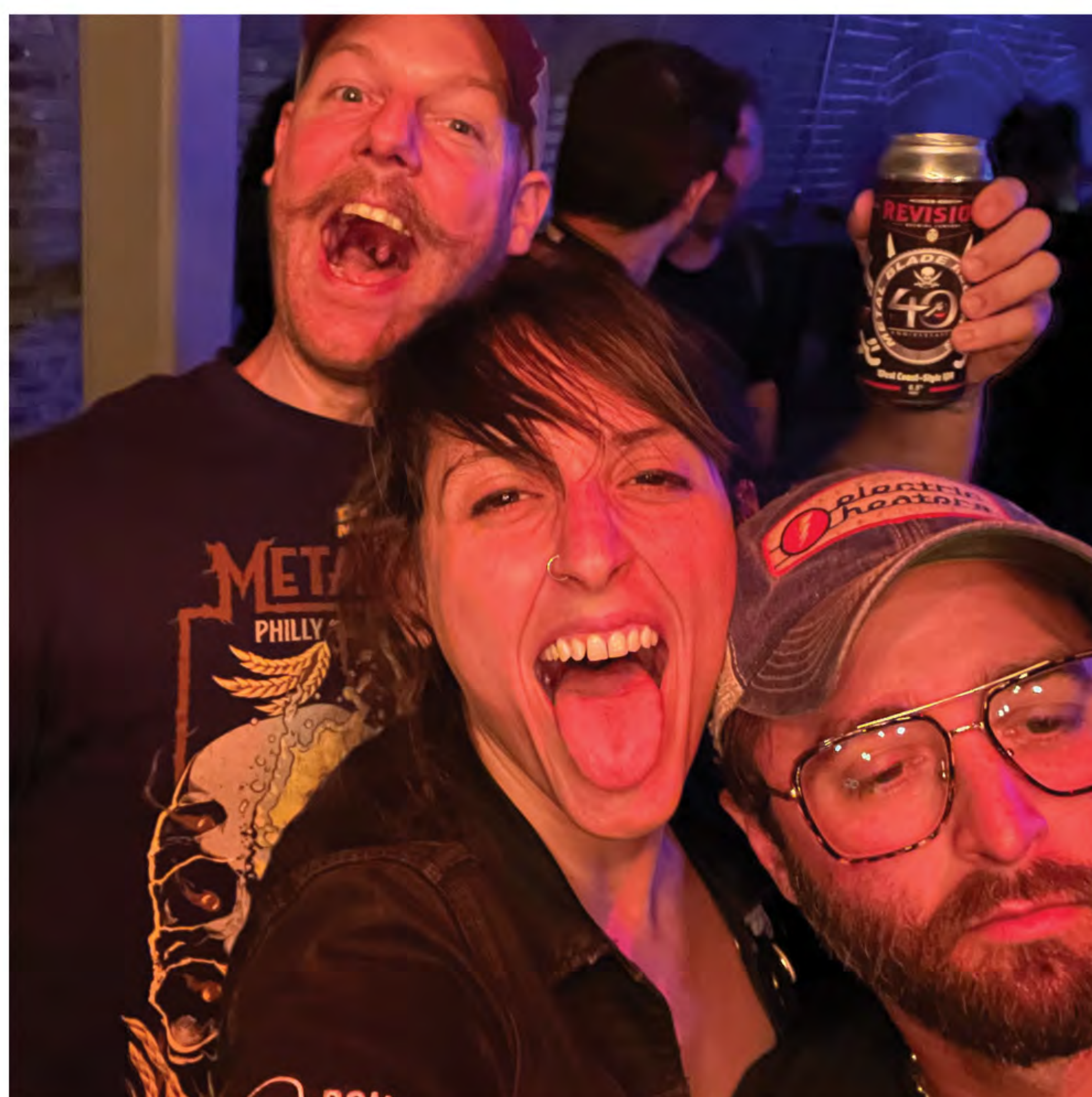






## BUBco DOES PHILLY

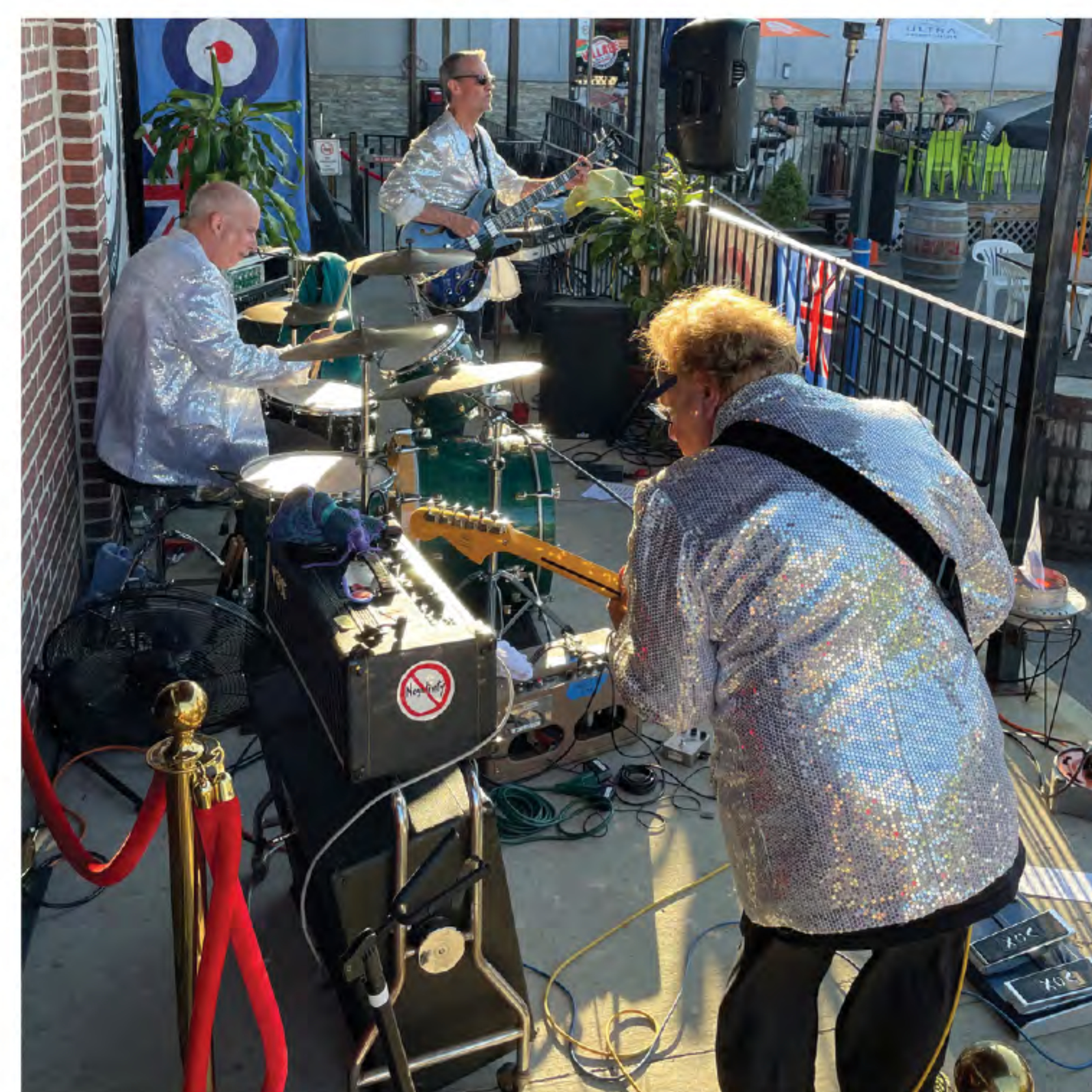






# WHERE'S CHRIS?

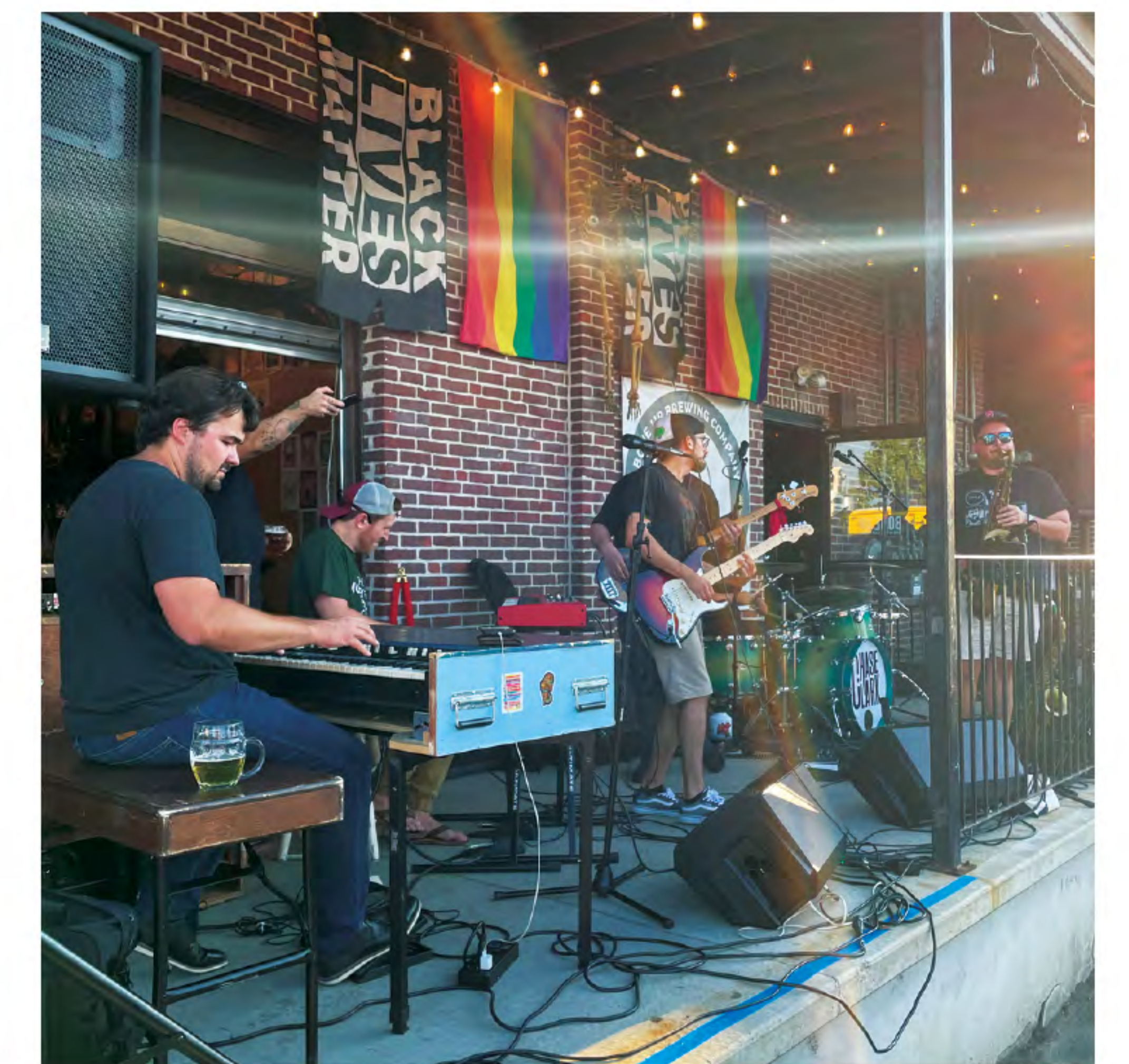

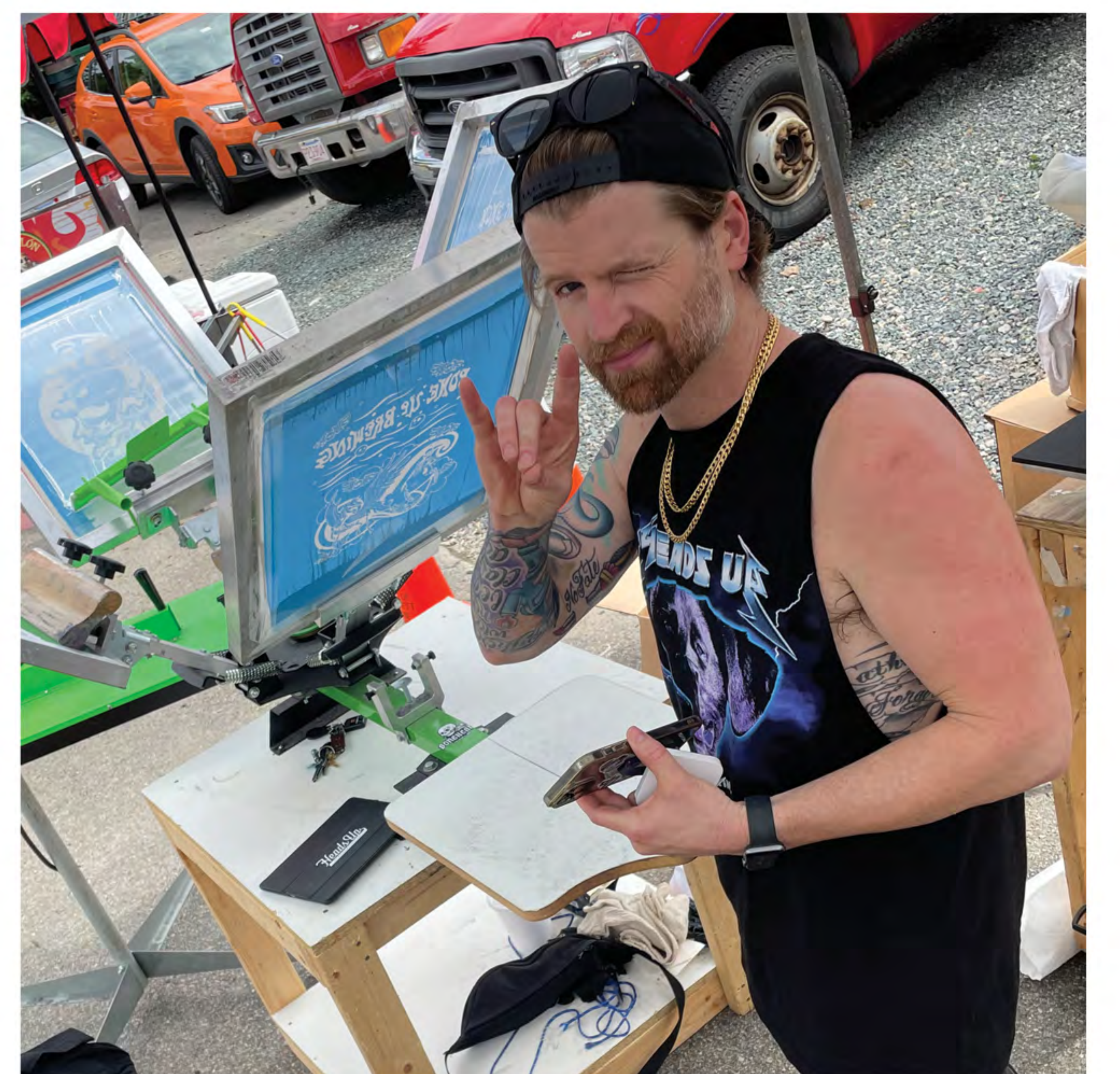
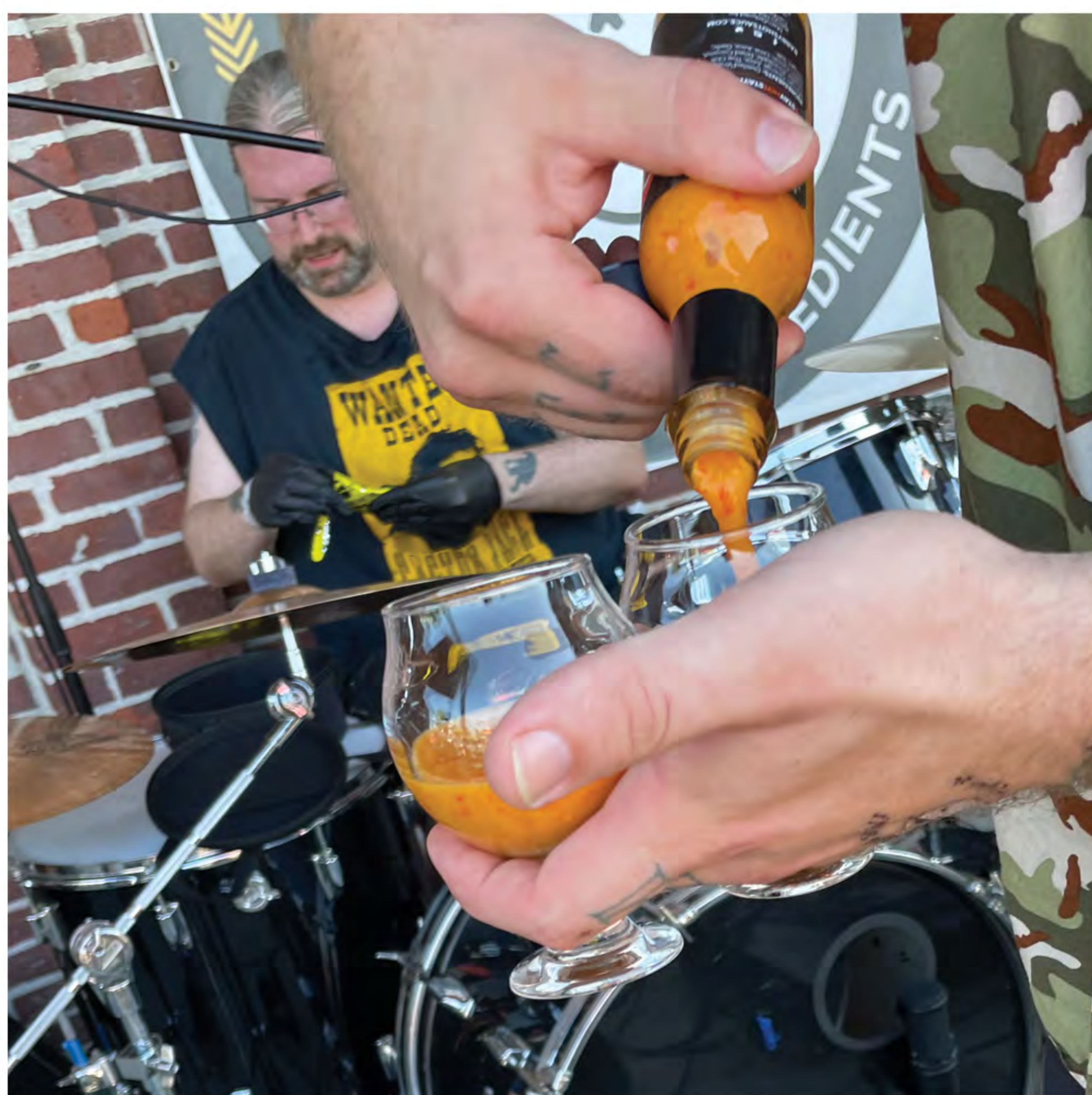

We hosted another PBS brewday (this time collaborating with Small Change), released a special collab blend with Brewery Silvaticus, filled up our cold room label wall and started wrapping around the back, brewed a big stupid barleywine for batch #600, made an ESB with some locally grown Galena (which was way more exciting for us than it should have been), celebrated Ben's five year work-aversary in the Hudson Valley, and welcomed Macon to the production team!

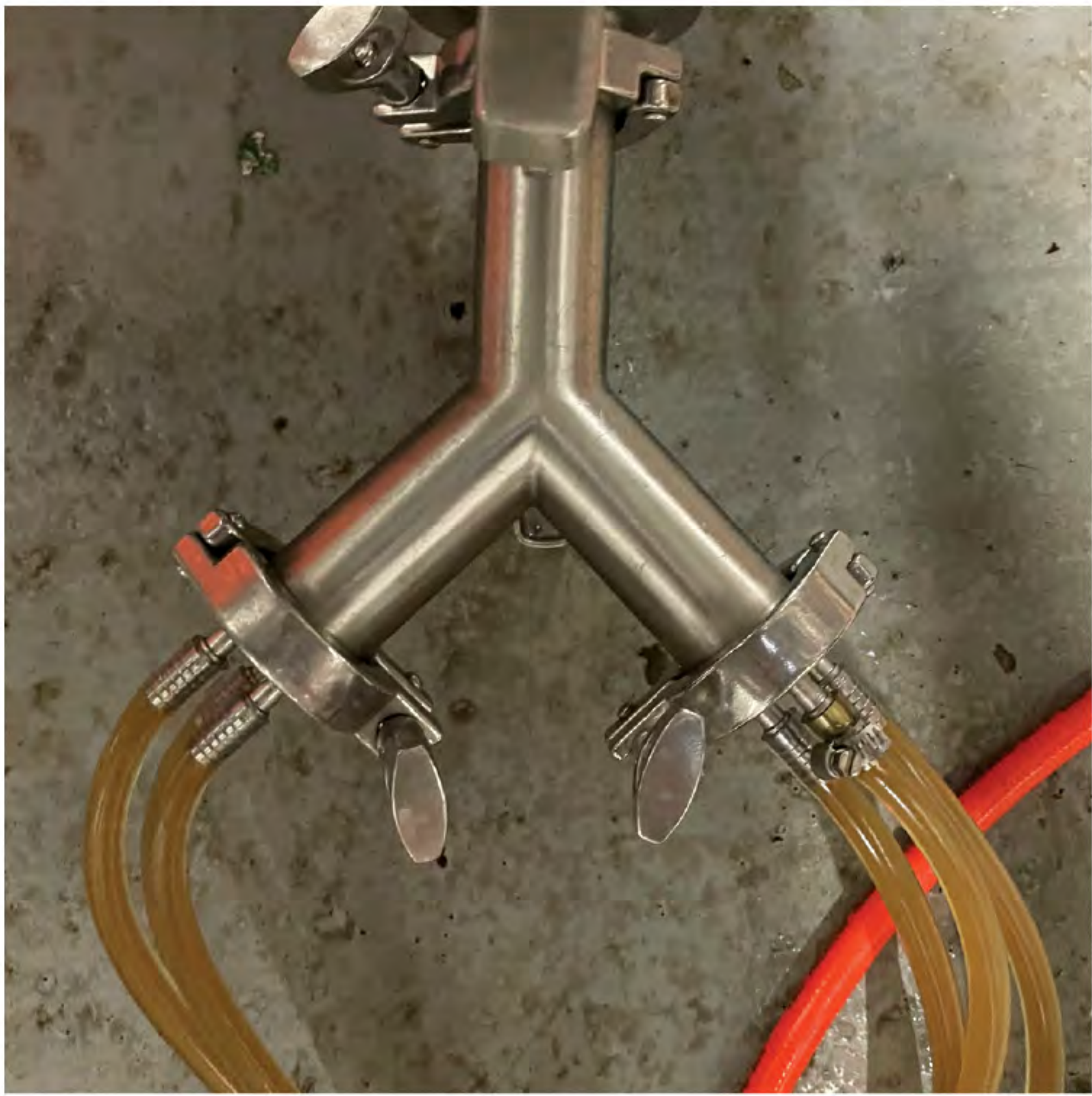


## HORATIO'S RESERVE

While it wasn't something that we released/sold, Horatio's Reserve Whiskey was the end product of a collab we did with GrandTen Distilling in 2018 where we basically did a recipe swap with them and they made a whiskey out of one of our beer recipes (the beer we made from their whiskey recipe went on to start our line of Critters beers, so it's one we remember quite fondly), and when the whiskey was finally done aging in the barrel this spring (totally worth the wait, it is smooth as heck), we stocked up on a whole bunch of it to enjoy in years to come!

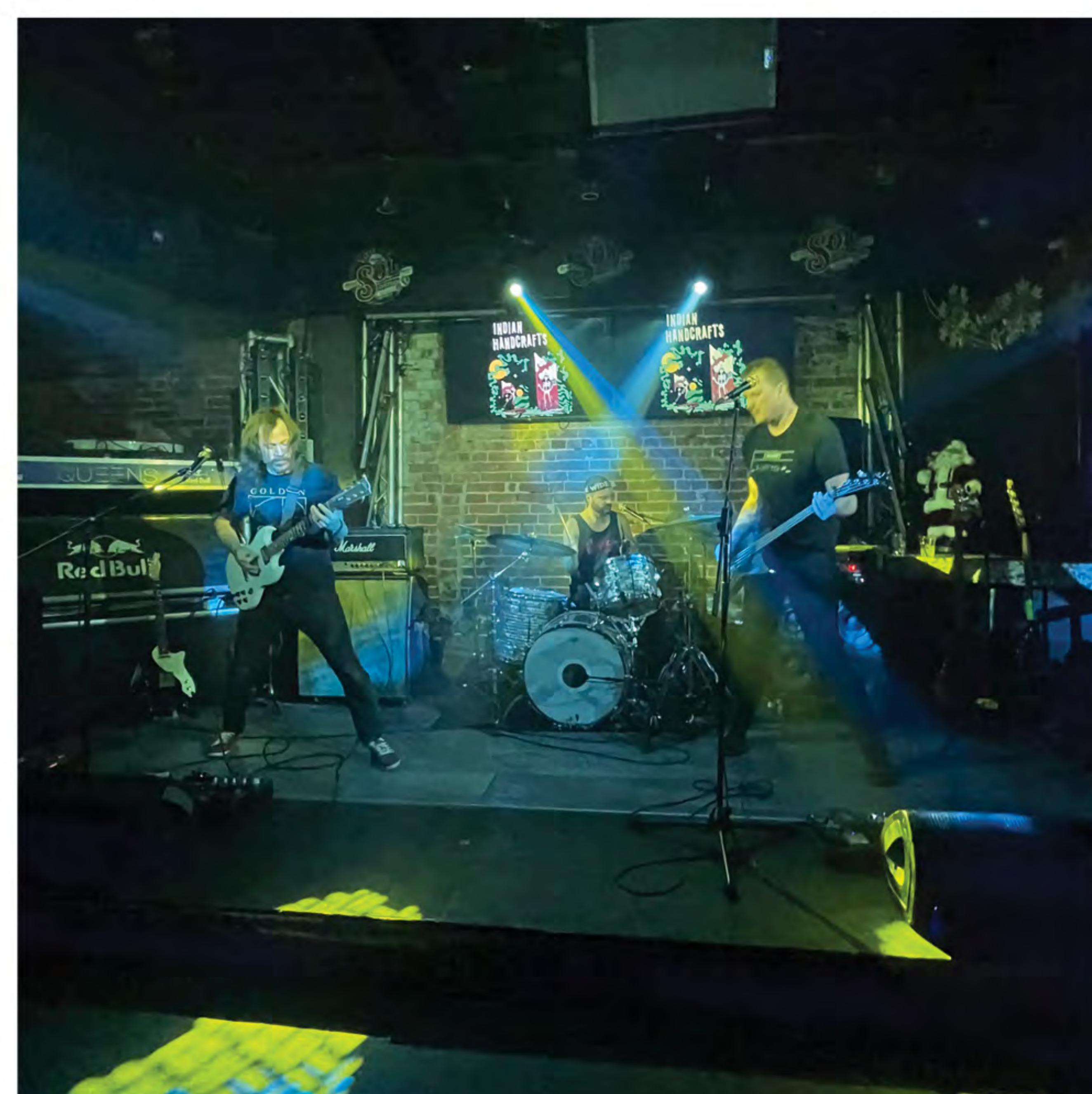
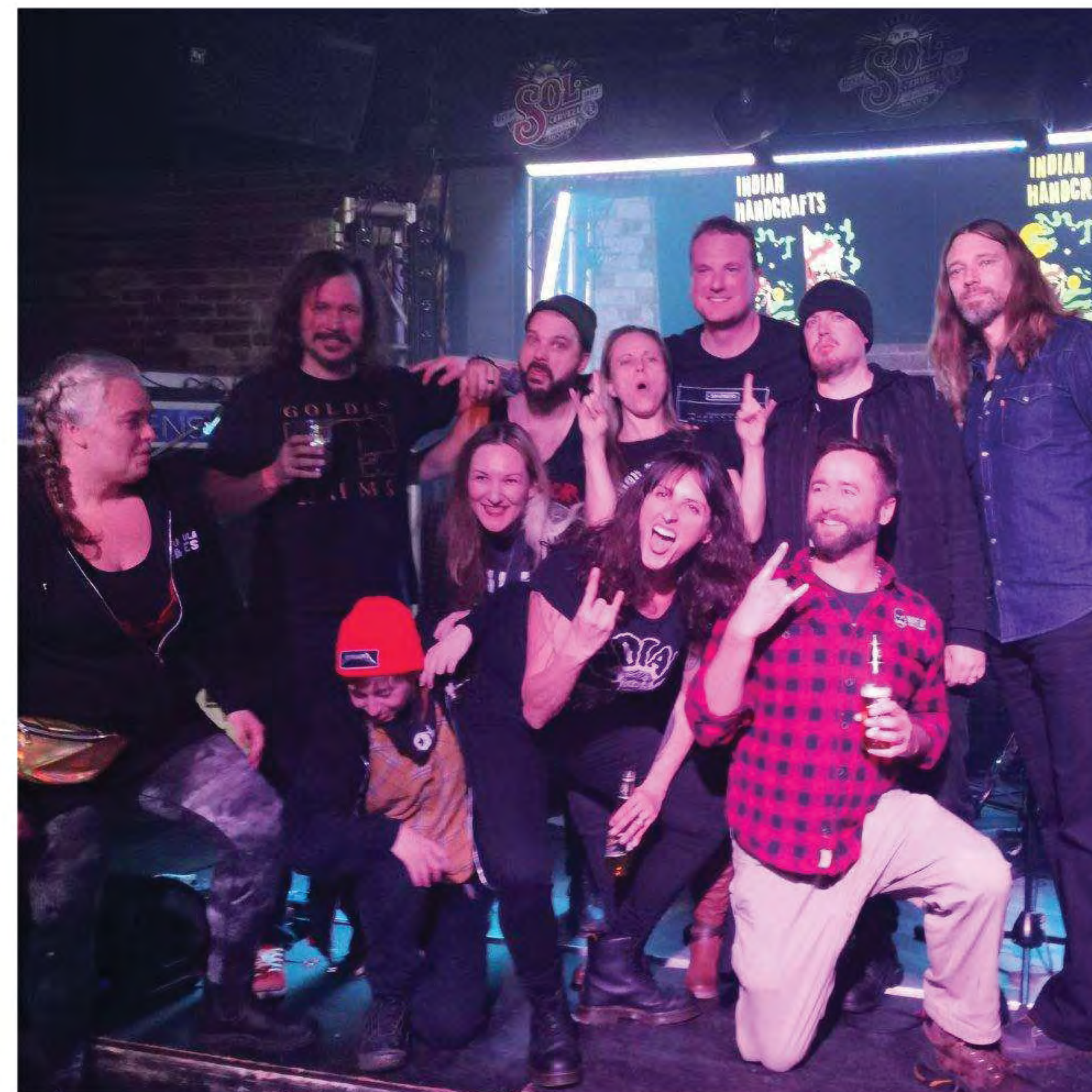




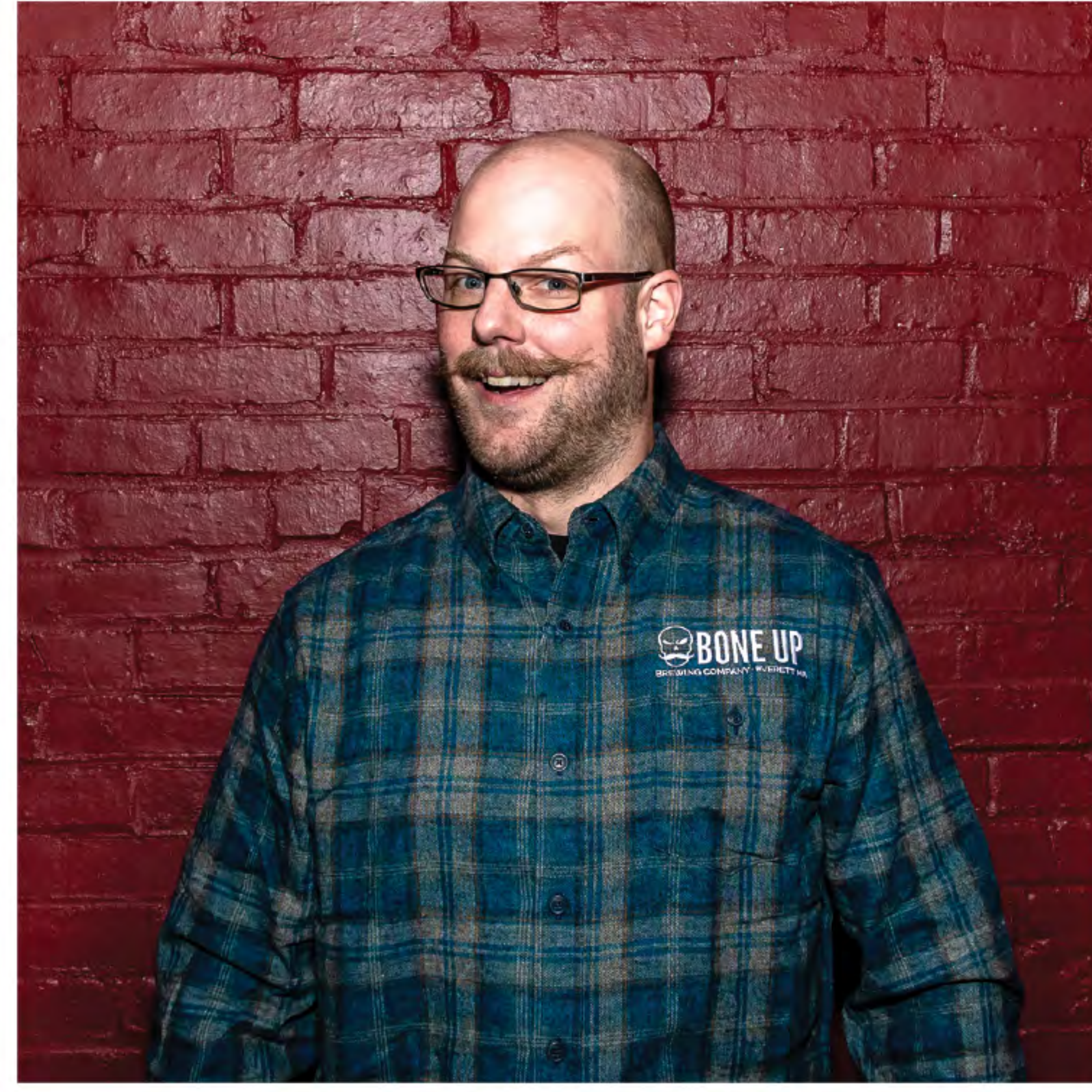


## BUBCO DOES CANADA

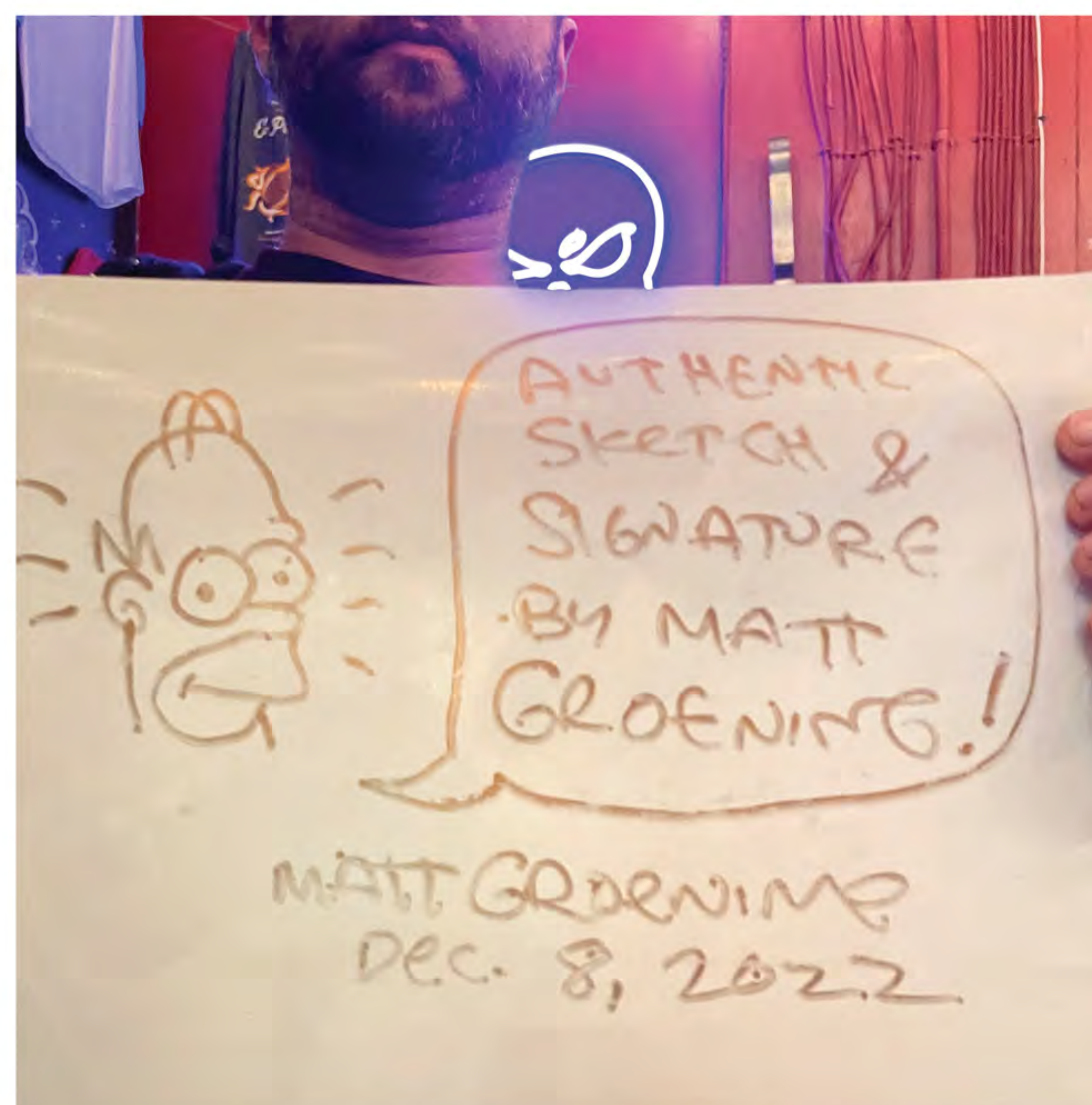
